**ABDON**. 1. A judge of Israel, in the time of the judges, Judg. 12:13-15. 2. A Levitical city, Josh. 21:30; 1 Chr. 6:74. 3. A Benjamite chief, 1 Chr. 8:23. 4. Son of Gibeon, 1 Chr. 8:30; 9:36. 5. Son of Micah, 2 Chr. 34:20. Called also **ACHBOR**, 2 Kin. 22:12.

**ABED-NEGO**, called also **AZARIAH**, a Jewish captive in Babylon, Dan. 1:6-20; 2:17, 49; 3:12-30; Heb. 11:34.

**ABEL**. 1. Son of Adam. History of, Gen. 4:1-15,25. References to the death of, Matt. 23:35; Luke 11:51; Heb. 11:4; 12:24; 1 John 3:12. 2. A stone, 1 Sam. 6:18.

**ABEL BETH MAACAH**. See **ABEL-BETH-MAACHAH**.

**ABEL-BETH-MAACHAH**, called also **ABEL-MAIM**. A city in the N. of Palestine. Sheba slain in, 2 Sam. 20:14-22. Taken by Ben Hadad, 1 Kin. 15:20; 2 Chr. 16:4; by Tiglath, 2 Kin. 15:29.

**ABEL BETHMAACHA.** See **ABEL-BETH-MAACHAH.**

**ABEL KERAMIM.** Judg. 11:33

**ABEL-MEHOLAH.** A city near the Jordan, Judg. 7:22; 1 Kin. 4:12. Elisha's birthplace, 1 Kin. 19:16.

**ABEL-MIZRAIM,** place where the Israelites mourned for Jacob, Gen. 50:11.

**ABEL-SHITTIM.** See **SHITTIM.**

**ABETTING.** See **COMPLICITY.**

**ABEZ,** a city of Issachar, Josh. 19:20.

**ABI,** mother of Hezekiah, 2 Kin. 18:2. Called **ABIJAH,** 2 Chr. 29:1.

**ABIA.** 1. Called also **ABIJAH,** chief of the twenty-four courses of priests, 1 Chr. 24:10; Neh. 12:4; Luke 1:5. 2. King of Judah. See **ABIJAM.**

**ABIAH.** 1. Wife of Hezron, 1 Chr. 2:24. 2. Son of Samuel, 1 Sam. 8:1-5; 1 Chr. 6:28.

**ABI-ALBON,** called also **ABIEL.** One of David's heroes, 2 Sam. 23:31; 1 Chr. 11:32.

**ABIASAPH,** son of Korah, Ex. 6:24.

**ABIATHAR.** 1. High priest. Called **AHIMELECH** in 2 Sam. 8:17; 1 Chr. 24:3,6,31, and **ABIMELECH,** 1 Chr. 18:16. Son of Ahimelech, 1 Sam. 22:20. Escapes to David from the vengeance of Saul, who killed the priests in the city of Nob, 1 Sam. 22:20-23, with vs. 6-19. Consults the ephod for David, 1 Sam. 22:10; 23:9; 30:7. Associate high priest with Zadok in the reign of David, 2 Sam. 15:35; 20:25; 1 Kin. 4:4; 1 Chr. 15:11, but called **AHIMELECH** and father of Abiathar, 2 Sam. 8:17; 1 Chr. 18:16. Loyal to David when Absalom rebelled; leaves Jerusalem with the ark of the covenant, but is directed by David to return with the ark, 2 Sam. 15:24-29. Aids David by sending his son from Jerusalem to David with secret information concerning the counsel of Ahithophel, 2 Sam. 15:35,36; 17:15-22; 1 Kin. 2:26. Supports Adonijah's pretensions to the throne, 1 Kin. 1:7. Thrust out of office by Solomon, 1 Kin. 2:26,27, with 1 Sam. 2:31-35. 2. See **AHIMELECH.**

**ABIB,** called also **NISAN.** First month in the Jewish calendar, Ex. 12:2. Passover instituted, and Israelites depart from Egypt in, Ex. 23:15; Deut. 16:1. Tabernacle set up in, Ex. 40:2,17. Israelites arrive at the wilderness of Zin in, Num. 20:1. Enter Canaan in, Josh. 4:19. Jordan's overflow in, 1 Chr. 12:15.

**ABIDA,** son of Midian, 1 Chr. 1:33. a descendant of Abraham, Gen. 25:4.

**ABIDAN.** Num. 1:11; 2:22; 7:60,65; 10:24

**ABIEZER.** 1. Called also **JEEZER,** progenitor of the Abiezrites, Num. 26:30; Josh. 17:2; Judg. 6:34; 8:2. 2. One of David's heroes, 2 Sam. 23:27; 1 Chr. 27:12.

**ABIGAIL.** 1. Nabal's wife. Her wisdom and tact, and marriage to David, 1 Sam. 25; 27:3; 2 Sam. 2:2. Mother of Chileab by David, 2 Sam. 3:3; 1 Chr. 3:1. Taken captive and rescued by David, 1 Sam. 30:1-18. 2. Sister of David, and mother of Amasa, 2 Sam.

17:25; 1 Chr. 2:16,17.

**ABIHAIL.** 1. Father of Esther, Esth. 2:15.2. The second wife of Rehoboam, 2 Chr. 11:18,19.3. Father of Zuriel, Num. 3:35.4. Wife of Abishur, 1 Chr. 2:29.

**ABIHU.** Son of Aaron, Ex. 6:23; Num. 3:2. Summoned by God to Sinai, Ex. 24:9. Called to the priesthood, Ex. 28:1. Death of, Lev. 10:1,2; Num. 26:61. Died childless, Num. 3:4.

**ABIHUD,** called also **AHIHUD,** son of Bela, 1 Chr. 8:3.

**ABIJAH.** 1. Son of Jeroboam, 1 Kin. 14:1-18.2. See **ABIA**; **ABIJAM.**

**ABIJAM,** called also **ABIJAH** and **ABIA.** King of Judah, 1 Kin. 14:31; 15:1; 2 Chr. 12:16. History of, 1 Kin. 15:1-8; 2 Chr. 11:22; 13. Succeeded by Asa, 1 Kin. 15:8; 2 Chr. 14:1.

**ABILENE,** a Roman province in Palestine, Luke 3:1.

**ABIMAEL,** son of Joktan, Gen. 10:28; 1 Chr. 1:22.

**ABIMELECH.** 1. King of Gerar, Gen. 20; 21:22-32.2. King of Gerar, Gen. 26.3. Son of Gideon, Judg. 8:31; 9; 2 Sam. 11:21.4. See **ACHISH**; **AHIMELECH.**

**ABINADAB.** 1. A Levite, in whose house the ark of God rested twenty years, 1 Sam. 7:1,2; 2 Sam. 6:3,4; 1 Chr. 13:7.2. Son of Jesse, 1 Sam. 16:8; 17:13.3. Called also **ISHUI,** son of Saul, 1 Sam. 14:49; 31:2.4. Father of one of Solomon's provision suppliers, 1 Kin. 4:11.

**ABINOAM,** father of Barak, Judg. 4:6.

**ABIRAM.** 1. An Israelite who conspired with Dathan against Moses and Aaron, Num. 16; 26:9,10; Deut. 11:6; Psa. 106:17.2. Son of Hiel, 1 Kin. 16:34.

**ABISHAG,** wife of David, 1 Kin. 1:1-4; 2:13-25.

**ABISHAI.** Son of Zeruiah, David's sister, 1 Chr. 2:16. One of David's chief men, 2 Sam. 23:18. Seeks Saul's life, 1 Sam. 26:6-8. Pursues and slays Abner, 2 Sam. 2:24; 3:30. Defeats the Edomites, 1 Chr. 18:12; the Ammonites, 2 Sam. 10:10,14. Seeks the life of Shimei, 2 Sam. 16:9; 19:21. Leads a division of David's army against Absalom, 2 Sam. 18:2,5. Overthrows Sheba, 2 Sam. 20:1-22. Saves David from being slain by a Philistine, 2 Sam. 21:17. Obtains water from the well of Bethlehem for David, 1 Chr. 11:15-20.

**ABISHALOM.** 1 Kin. 15:2,10. See **ABSALOM.**

**ABISHUA.** 1. A high priest, 1 Chr. 6:4,5,50.2. A son of Bela, 1 Chr. 8:4.

**ABISHUR,** son of Shammai, 1 Chr. 2:28,29.

**ABITAL,** wife of David, 2 Sam. 3:4; 1 Chr. 3:3.

**ABITUB,** a Benjamite, 1 Chr. 8:11.

**ABIUD,** ancestor of Jesus, Matt. 1:13.

**ABNER,** son of Ner. Cousin of Saul, 1 Sam. 14:50,51, with 1 Sam. 9:1. Captain of the army, 1 Sam. 14:50; 17:55; 26:5,14. Dedicated spoils of war to the tabernacle, 1 Chr. 26:27,28. Loyalty of, to the house of Saul, 2 Sam. 2:8-32. Alienation of, from the house of Saul, 2 Sam. 3:6-21. Murdered by Joab; David's sorrow for, 2 Sam. 3:27-39.
